Senior Staff Surgeries are informal, drop-in Q&A sessions where tenants can speak directly with GWhA senior staff about issues that matter to them.

These surgeries build on the Community Engagement Events (CEVs) held in Year 1 (2024) and Year 2 (2025). From 2026, CEVs have been replaced with quarterly Senior Staff Surgeries (Q1–Q3), while the Annual Tenant Conference continues each January (Q4).

What happens next?

Following each Senior Staff Surgery, we will publish a clear “You said, we did” update. These quarterly updates will:

- Summarise the key issues and questions raised by tenants
- Show what actions have been agreed, who is responsible, and the current status
- Be clear about what can be resolved quickly and what will take longer, including why

This ensures issues raised at surgeries are logged, tracked, and reported back, closing the feedback loop and showing how tenant input directly influences decisions and services.

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
